- ~ Vaccinations must be current for outdoor cats only.
- ~ Cats must be free of parasites and infectious diseases.

FULL-SERVICE GROOMING RATES

- ~ Short hair cats - \$40
- ~ Medium hair cats - \$45
- ~ Long hair cats - \$50
- ~ Lion Cut - \$85 & up , based on condition of coat (includes full service grooming)
- ~ Comb-Cut - \$100.00 & up (Lion Cut variation; includes full service grooming)

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

- ~ Sanitary clip - \$10
- ~ Tummy and sanitary clip - \$25
- ~ Jojoba hot oil treatment - \$10
- ~ Full pedicure - \$10
- ~ Rear only pedicure - \$6
- ~ Soft Paws and pedicure - \$20
- ~ Toe tuft trim - \$10

ADDITIONAL FEES

- ~ Cats 12 lbs. & over - \$10
- ~ Cats 20 lbs. & over - \$20
- ~ De-matting - \$5 & up, based on time required
- ~ Handling fee for difficult cats - \$10 & up, based on time required

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

If coming from Aurora/Highway 99:

- ~ go to 205th St. where Edmonds meets Shoreline
- ~ turn west on 205th St. (which becomes Firdale) and go 3/4 mile

If coming from I-5:

- ~ take exit #177 (Edmonds/Kingston ferry) and continue on 104 West for approximately 2 miles
- ~ turn left on 100th Avenue West and go 1 mile; Firdale Village is on the left

REGULAR GROOMING PROMOTES GOOD HEALTH FOR YOUR CAT

- ~ **No matting.** A regular bath eliminates the grease and grime that goes into your cat's fur and causes mats.
- ~ **Less Expensive.** Time equals money. It takes more time and more work to groom a kitty that comes in once a year versus every six weeks.
- ~ **Less shedding.** A cat that gets groomed on a regular basis sheds a lot less. A good bath loosens up all the dead hair which gets in your house and on you.
- ~ **Less hairballs.** The less dead hair your cat licks off will lessen the hairball problem considerably.
- ~ **Less dander.** A good bath can lessen dander on a cat, which helps kitty and people with allergies.
- ~ **Less stress.** A cat that gets groomed on a regular basis handles the grooming much better than a cat that comes in only when in trouble. This means a happier cat and less of a chance you will pay handling fees for the "hard to handle" cat.
- ~ **Early detection.** Groomers are privy to finding health issues before they become urgent. This will mean a healthier, longer life for kitty. Keeping the skin clean is much healthier for everyone.
